- Full payment at the time of registration.
- Fees payable to: The Village of Mamaroneck, unless otherwise stated.
- Classes are not pro-rated regardless of when you register.
- Non-residents welcome in most programs at a higher rate.

- Refunds will not be given after the start of the first class.

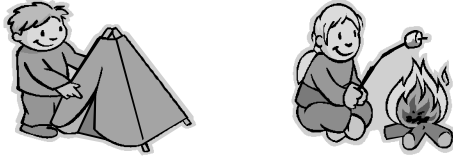

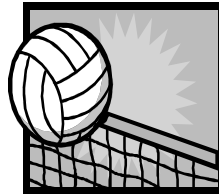

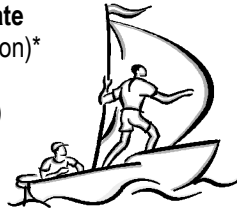
