**Opening Protocol:**

- Meeting was called to order at 7:09 by Aber, seconded by Norberto.
- Kiriakou made a motion to approve June's minutes with several attendance changes noted below, seconded by Sable-Friedman.
  - June minutes corrections – add O'Rourke as an attendee, note Norberto as absent.

**July 4<sup>th</sup> Concert (July 2023):**

- Congrats to De Santis on another successful July 4<sup>th</sup> concert!
- De Santis was able to promote the upcoming summer pop-up concerts during the show (thank you!).

**3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Summer Pop Up Concert Series (July 2023):**

- Three bands have been finalized and booked:
  - African Music Mercenaries (Columbus Park) – July 7
  - Carlos Jimenez (Florence Park) – July 21
  - Alexander & Slepovitch Duo (Mary Louise Cox Poetry Garden) – July 28
- Stevens will provide R. Ingenito with the flyer file for a request of 75 copies

**Village of Mamaroneck Concert Series (Summer 2023):**

- Concerts will be Broadway band (July 19) and Springsteen cover band (Aug 9).

**Shakespeare in the Park (August 19, 2023):**

- Unfortunately, due to a potential strike in the industry, this year's Shakespeare in the Park has been cancelled.
- The founder of the Irvington Shakespeare Company has provided several other options for the summer.
  - Lerchen will continue to discuss opportunities and will report back to the group over the coming weeks.
  - Lerchen will connect Norberto with the head of the Irvington Shakespeare Company for further discussions re: strike.

- Lerchen will also reach out to the Hudson Valley about potential availability.

**Marketing:**

- We are looking for several high school volunteers to help build social media content.
- Two applicants have shared their portfolios and interest in the position.
  - Lerchen and Stevens will meet with them in the coming weeks to provide assignments for the summer based on the recommended content plan.

**Juneteenth:**

- Film Festival presentation has been prepared to show with potential sponsors and participants. Kiriakou will share more specific next steps prior to the September meeting.
