Climate Smart Communities Task Force 2023 Accomplishments

- 1. <u>Bronze Certification</u>- We have met the requirements to file an application for the Village to obtain Bronze Certification in early January. The Village has completed 19 CSC Actions for a total of 168 points.
- 2. <u>CSC Webpage</u> Created a webpage on the Village website for the CSC Task Force to inform the public about the CSC program, the Village's climate action and information on how individuals can take climate action
- 3. <u>Climate Change Education and Engagement</u> completed a comprehensive report showcasing the depth and breadth of the education and engagement work, consisting of sponsored events and public outreach of the CFTE and CSC over the past year.
- 4. <u>Comprehensive Plan Memorandum</u> Prepared memorandum outlining the sustainable elements of the newly adopted Comprehensive Plan to make it eligible for CSC credit.
- 5. <u>Fleet Inventory</u> Completed a fleet inventory for all Village vehicles. This is a prerequisite action for other actions targeting reduction of fleet emissions.
- 6. <u>Documentation</u> Gathered and uploaded the required documentation for a host of past Village actions to get credit for them in the CSC program.
- 7. <u>CSC Logo</u> Created a logo for the Village of Mamaroneck CSC program to create awareness of the Village's climate efforts and accomplishments. This logo is used in reports, digital communications and in social media postings.

In Progress

- 1. <u>Climate Action Plan</u> Ellen, Liam and Dan completed a 5-session program with Hudson Valley Regional Council to create a Government Operations Climate Action Plan. A resolution was passed to begin work on the project. Completion is expected by Q1 2024 after a public comment period.
- 2. <u>Energy Smart Homes Community Campaign</u> Debbie has been working in partnership with Sustainable Westchester on this campaign to inform the public about heat pumps and other energy smart alternatives.
