

Dear Volunteers,

On behalf of the Village of Mamaroneck's Committee for the Environment, I want to thank you for volunteering for the Village of Mamaroneck Community Clean Up on Saturday, April 13th at 9:30am.

All volunteers are encouraged to gather near the Marine Education Center at Harbor Island Park at 9:30am for some opening remarks and to pick up clean-up supplies (trash bags and gloves).

If you cannot attend the opening remarks at 9:30am at Harbor Island Park, you can also meet at your specific cleanup location around 10:00am or 10:30am, but you will need to bring your own supplies.

Here are some additional items ahead of Saturday's event to keep in mind:

- 1. Please check your email and/or the Village's website for any additional announcements.
- 2. During the Clean and Green Day event, the Village will provide FREE garden compost soil to Village residents at Harbor Island Park. Each household in the Village of Mamaroneck can fill up to one 32-gallon receptacle (bring your own receptacle). Proof of Village of Mamaroneck Residency may be required. (Click here for the flyer.)
- 3. After the 9:30am opening remarks, volunteer teams will set out to their clean-up locations. Site clean-up should be over by 12:00pm (if not earlier).
- 4. Most clean-up sites have a Team Leader. For teams without an assigned leader, we will speak with team members at check in to be sure you know where to go.
- 5. Please beware that some clean-up sites may have poison ivy. We recommend folks know how to identify poison ivy. - 6. ALL volunteers must complete a waiver. To save time, download, print, read and complete the waiver <u>HERE</u>, and bring it with you to the Community Clean Up. Otherwise, you will need to complete one at check in at 9:30am.
- 7. If your child needs a Community Service Letter, they MUST BE at check in. Any questions, contact cfte@vomny.org
