Village of Mamaroneck Climate Smart Communities Task Force Minutes for March 1, 2022 meeting held via zoom

We discussed the implementation of utilizing the \$10,000 grant money for the two grants awarded by NYSERDA in the fall. The first \$5,000 grant will be used to purchase LED 60-watt equivalent bulbs to give away to lower-income residents. Jerry will get quotes from 2-3 wholesalers to follow purchasing protocol; he believes the cost will be \$1 - \$1.50 per bulb. We decided not to purchase from ConEd since they require the addresses for each recipient and it would add a layer of complication to the distribution process. Tom has been in contact Malcolm Frouman from the Larchmont Mamaroneck Hunger Task Force to help with the distribution. The LMHTF has agreed to put the bulbs in food bags that get handed out to over 700 people. Robert Ingenito will prepare a bi-lingual flyer to inform residents about the energy efficiency of the bulbs.

The second \$5,000 grant will be utilized to purchase electric park maintenance equipment. Jeff Ahne and his Parks Dept. staff recently attended a seminar about converting equipment to electric and he will be helpful in supplying a list of electric equipment he thinks the Village should purchase. Once equipment is decided upon, Jerry will issue the purchase order.

A CSC Task Force email distribution list has been established by Jerry which will make communications much simpler.
