

Community Announcements Ahead of American Legion Post 90's Memorial Day Parade and Observances

The Village of Mamaroneck is delighted and grateful the American Post Legion 90's Memorial Day Parade and Observances will return to our community this year. The Village of Mamaroneck has put together this Community Announcement to provide the public with important information.

Date:

- The American Legion Post 90's Memorial Day Parade and Observances is scheduled to kick off at 5:00pm on Sunday, May 29. (Please note this is NOT on the observed holiday of Memorial Day, which falls on Monday, May 30.)

Route:

The Parade will assemble (beginning at approximately 4:00pm) in the vicinity of Mamaroneck Avenue School before proceeding down Mamaroneck Avenue. The parade then turns right on Prospect Avenue and will then proceed to the monument across the street from the American Legion Post 90 Hall at 189 Prospect Avenue. At the Monument, there will be a ceremony of tributes and remembrances, which will include a rifle salute, in dedication to our fallen.

Street Closures:

On Sunday, May 29, the Village's Police Department will begin shutting down Mamaroneck Avenue to vehicle traffic at approximately 4:00pm. All streets with egress to Mamaroneck Avenue will be closed (except for residents/business patrons). This includes:

Gertrude Ave from Ralph Ave to Mamaroneck Ave
New Street from Ralph Ave to Mamaroneck Ave
Grand Street from Madison St to Mamaroneck Ave
Old White Plains Rd at Mamaroneck Ave
Waverly Ave from Plaza Ave to Mamaroneck Ave
Hoyt Ave from Fenimore Rd to Mamaroneck Ave
Mt. Pleasant Ave from Stanley Ave to Mamaroneck Ave
Palmer Ave from Mt Pleasant Ave to Mamaroneck Ave

Prospect Ave from Library Lane to Mamaroneck Ave
Nostrand Ave from Lester Ave to Mamaroneck Ave
Jefferson Ave Ext at Mamaroneck Ave
Van Ranst Pl at Mamaroneck Ave
Halstead Ave from Ward Ave to Mamaroneck Ave
Spencer Place from Philips Park Rd to Mamaroneck Ave
East Prospect Ave from Tompkins Ave to Mt. Pleasant Ave

Mamaroneck Avenue will then be closed from North Barry Avenue to Boston Post Road until the end of the parade (approximately 6:00pm).

Please note that driving in and around the Village and parking may be difficult. Parking is available at Harbor Island Park. The resident and non-resident weekend fee for parking (until 8:00pm) is \$12.00 per car. Our thanks to the Village of Mamaroneck's Police Department who will be on hand to provide a safe experience for all. As always, please be mindful when parking in front of neighbors' homes. Residents who have guests visiting for the parade should remind their guests to avoid blocking fire hydrants, driveways, or walkways.
