

Here are the steps for registering via the website.

1.) Go to www.prepare.ny.gov

2.) Scroll down and click the tab that says "Training Calendar"

3.) Type " Westchester" in the small search bar

4.) Select the word "Register" on the right hand side of the screen next to Mamaroneck UMC. 1/27/24

5.) Fill in the required information and select "Done" at the bottom of the page.

Here are the steps for registering via the QR.

1.) Using the camera on a mobile device, scan the QR code.

2.) Click the link that appears on the screen.

3.) Fill in the required information and select "**Done**" at the bottom of the page.

Each family, not person, will be given I disaster preparedness kit at the session.

The kit contains a first aid kit, flashlight with battery, transistor radio, gloves, waterproof tarp, N95 mask, duct tape, glowstick, whistle, googles, collapsible water jug and emergency blanket.
