
HISTORY

Built in 1926 and designed by renowned theatre architect Thomas Lamb, The Capitol Theatre was originally a celebrated vaudeville and movie hall.

In the early 1970s a who's who of rock and roll royalty graced The Cap's stage before the theatre went dark for many years.

DAYGLO purchased the property in 2012 and spent millions to lovingly restore the rock palace to its original splendor. Beyond the extensive interior renovations, DAYGLO installed the finest sound, lighting and video equipment, completing the dream of creating the ultimate destination for both music fans and musicians. No detail was too small.

From the layout of the bars, to the slope of the floor, to the sightlines from every corner of the room, each decision was guided by the principle of giving fans the best possible music and hospitality experience.
