- 1) The Committee had requested that Dan obtain the dollar damages from the 2007, 2011 and 2012 flood events. Peggy suggested that the data may be available under "flood claims" and that FEMA should have that data. Has this been done?
- 2) At our meeting in July, George Latimer suggested the VoM send a letter addressed to both him and Catherine Parker. The letter should inquire if the money the County set aside for the ACE Project, approximately \$10,000,000, was still available. Has this been done?
- 3) Save the Sound Bacteria monitoring data for Road to Nowhere

Peggy explained to Tom that we are trying to get water sample reports for the area at the extension of Glendale Avenue and Harrison, four blocks up from the Winfield Avenue Bridge. Rob Stark followed up with Save the Sound but the only testing which has been done was at the Winfield Avenue Bridge. This committee has requested testing be conducted below the Road to Nowhere for more than a year. This was not done. The testing from the Winfield Ave bridge is not applicable. When will this be requested and when will the results be available?

4) Weather Service

Need to follow up with Dan on whether to use another Weather Service. This committee suggested that the service the VOM is using has been extremely inaccurate predicting more than 6" rainstorms on 2 occasions while NOAA, Weather Underground and AccuWeather which are free were significantly more accurate. Has this been looked into?

- 5) This committee has sent suggested legislation to the Board of Trustees on three points. What is the status of the consideration of this legislation?
- 6) Any updates on the Waverley Ave Bridge?
- 7) Re current discussion regarding suggested setbacks from water bodies in commercial areas- Why wasn't this brought up to this committee at the time it was first proposed? I read through the documents forwarded by Trustee Wenstrup, and I certainly could have missed references, but I didn't understand why no reference

was made to FEMA standards and FEMA flood maps. Shouldn't this be considered?

- 8) Further discussion about 1606 Ellis and the flood way. Also, the flood vents are at least 3' over the level of the property. Shouldn't they be much closer to ground level (mine are about 6" over the level of the ground) to maintain hydrostatic pressure?
- 9) Discussion of the local law requiring no illegal sump pump connections so that our newest member can understand the law and why it was put in place.
