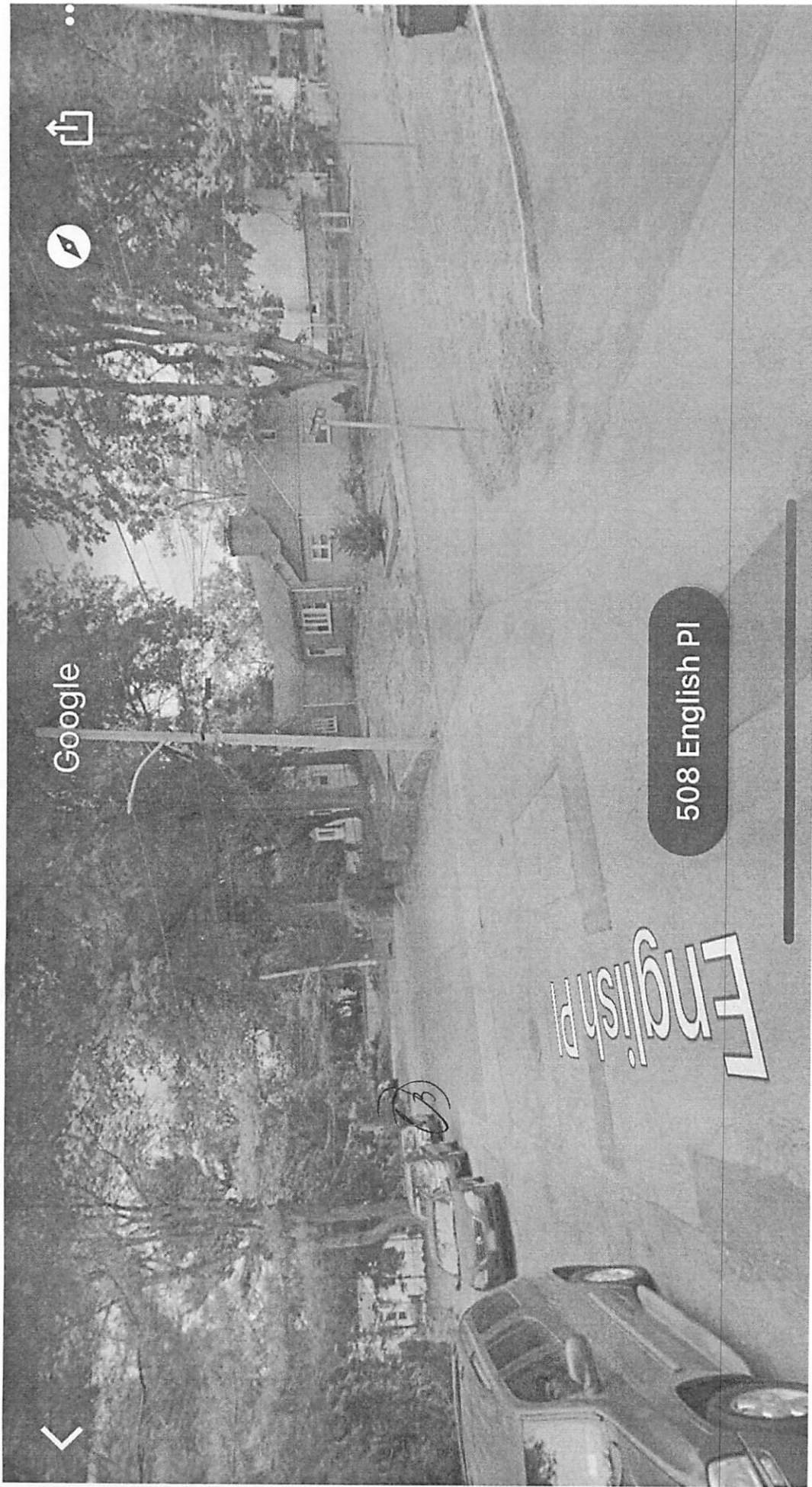

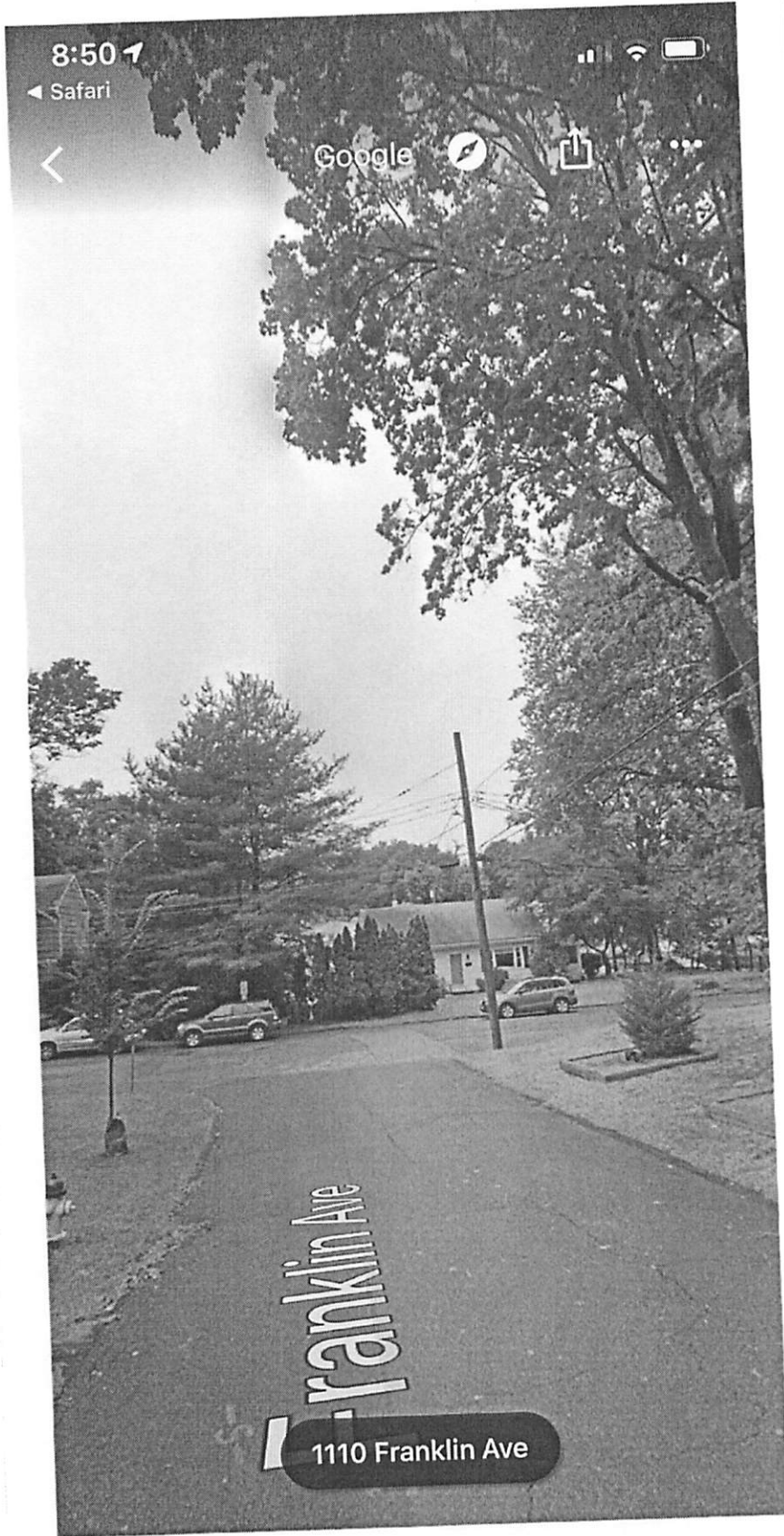

Describe incident details:

Taylor's Lane – The Village of Mamaroneck (VOM) needs to be proactive immediately due to the excessive daily speeding on Taylor's Lane. There is severe concern throughout the neighborhood that the speeding will cause serious injury to pedestrians, joggers, bicyclists, drivers, and wildlife.

Shadow Lane – Same commentary as above and please understand there are seven houses on Shadow Lane. The daily car count is 80 to 100 cars (pre-pandemic count was well in excess of 100 cars). There are groups of people walking, jogging, and biking during this difficult time and their safety should be a priority

Please keep in mind that there are no sidewalks, so people need to be on the street.

Describe desired outcome:

Taylor's Lane – The Traffic Commission should explore installing passive speed bumps or other options that will reduce the speeding.

Shadow/Taylor's Lanes - Three-way stop sign at intersection and signage including speed limits and electronic "School Zone Signs" Speeds are well in excess of the limit and it occurs on a daily basis, throughout the day.

We willing to work with the VOM to collectively explore solutions that are practical and feasible. SOMETHING NEEDS TO BE DONE RIGHT AWAY.
