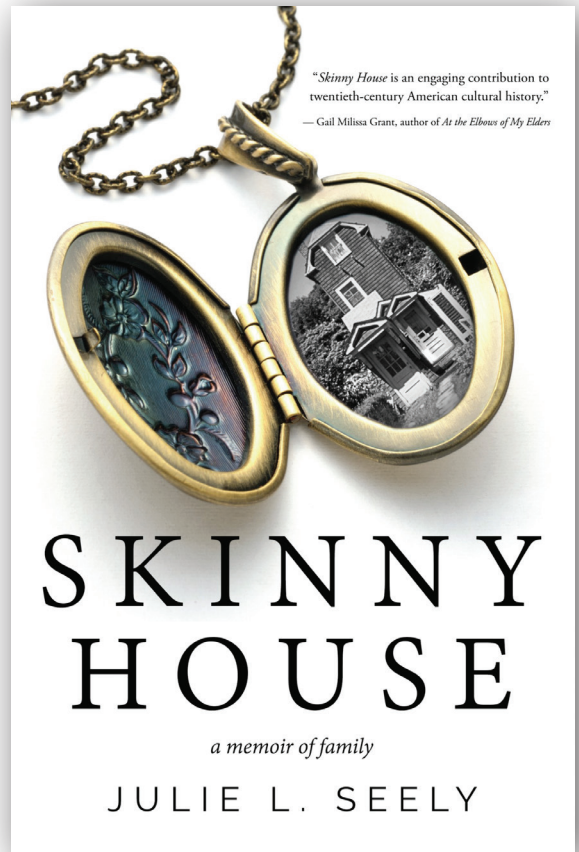

During the Great Depression, Seely's grandfather, Nathan, built and lived in the historic "Skinny House" — a 10-foot wide, three-story home on Grand Street in Mamaroneck. Nathan, one of the first African-American home builders in the state, helped many fellow African-Americans who moved North during the Great Migration — until the carpet was yanked from under him.
