

## LANDSCAPING SERVICES LIMITED TO MAINTENANCE AND PEST CONTROL OPERATIONS ONLY

Pursuant Executive Order 202.8, all non-essential businesses in NY State are required to reduce their in-person work force by 100%. The Executive Order gave <u>Empire State Development</u> (esd.ny.gov) the sole authority to determine which types of businesses and activities are considered "essential".

Regarding landscaping services, <u>Empire State Development</u> advised that only maintenance and pest control work are considered "essential." Cosmetic work – for example new planting – is considered non-essential

Per the <u>Empire State Development</u> Guidance Maintenance are those items that promote safety and sanitation.

<b><u>Permitted</u></b>	Not Permitted
Lawn Mowing	New Plantings
Spring Cleanup	Mulching
Hedge Trimming	Removal of Plants (non-safety related)

Landscape maintenance crews are required to maintain social distancing standards of Six Feet (6').
