

## Village of Mamaroneck Municipal Code, Section 326-19 A

Section 326 - 19(A) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby enacted to restrict the idling of motor vehicle engines and shall read as follows:

- A. No person shall cause or permit the engine of a motor vehicle, other than a legally authorized emergency motor vehicle or any government vehicle engaged in official government business, to idle for longer than three minutes on Village-owned property or a street, road or highway within the Village while parking, as defined in § 129 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, while standing, as defined in § 145 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, or while stopping, as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law, unless the engine is used to operate a loading, unloading or processing device.
- B. When the ambient temperature is in excess of 40° F., no person shall cause or permit the engine of a bus, as defined in § 104 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, to idle while parking, standing or stopping on Village-owned property.
