Although we're not responsible for removals, the Tree Committee is putting together a list of stumps. This is from Gwen Farassat. I live at 735 The Parkway and believe we are neighbors. I am reaching out to you because I see that you are cochair of the Village's Tree Committee. The Village recently, without notice, cut down a tree from the front of our property and there is now a stump where the tree used to be. I called the Village's Department of Public Works to find out whether we are responsible for having the stump ground-down or whether the Village does it and also whether the Village will plant a replacement tree or whether that is our responsibility. I was told by the woman in the Department of Public Works who answered my call that the Village will grind down the stump but will not do it until next winter and that I should reach out to Ellen Silver of the Committee for the

Environment regarding tree replacement. I reached out to Ellen about tree replacement and she, in turn, referred me to the Tree Committee.

As the co-chair of the Tree Committee, can you let me know whether the Village will replace the tree it cut down from the front of our property, and if so, when, or if it will not do it, whether we are permitted to plant a new tree in the spot where the old tree was.
