What a beautiful tree! The crown looks completely healthy so I agree that it's worth getting a trustworthy second opinion.

The Village uses an arborist named Frank Buddingh to evaluate trees. He will tell you if he thinks a tree needs to come out, but very strongly favors judicious pruning and organic remedies that strengthen a tree and increase its resistance to diseases whenever possible.
