Thank you Nora,

I have a few questions that will help clarify my understanding. Perhaps they can answered before our packed agenda tomorrow night. They are concentrated on pages 7-9, as follows:

- 318-8-A This section allows removal of 1 or 2 trees less than 8" without a permit?
Consequently, there is no requirement to replant?
If this is correct, should we say so explicitly or do you think there is a risk of encouraging people to take out 1-2 trees?
- 318-8 F (1) (1) box
Change line 1 to 'Under 6" No replanting necessary' to conform with the dbh in the Clear Cutting definition
Move each replanting requirement up one line, ending with '49" or greater 5 2-inch to 2 1/2" dbh trees'
Add that trees with height greater than 30' at maturity must be replaced with species with similar height at maturity
- 218-8 F (2) (a & b)
Seems redundant given that we have addressed this with the box in F (1) (1)
