The Office of the Westchester County Clerk is pleased to announce the release of *Westchester Records Online*, a web-based application from which customers can search for information and records filed in the clerk's office.

Westchester Records Online features a number of enhancements, including many that subscribers have brought to our attention over the last few years and also during the test period of this application. They include:

- Clear instructions directing a user on how to search different databases
- Land, Legal, Maps, Reports and Trades License searches from one location
- The opportunity to select a preferred image viewer to facilitate faster review of lengthy documents
- Inclusion of index maps allowing online searchers to locate county block numbers
- Improved tools for searching our Land Records Index books

Our current Westchester County Clerk's Public Viewer will remain available through Friday, March 12th to give you the opportunity to transition to *Westchester Records Online*. After March 12th, the Public Viewer will no longer be available.
