LOCAL LAW 2 OF 2020

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 72 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF MAMARONECK (TRAFFIC COMMISSION) REGARDING THE DESIGNATION OF EX OFFICIO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS AS NON-VOTING MEMBERS

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

Section 1.

Section 72-1 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is amended as follows:

§ 72-1 Membership.

The Board of Traffic Commissioners will consist of seven community members appointed by the Board of Trustees, who will be voting members of the Board, and two ex officio members. The ex officio members will be the Chief of the Mamaroneck Fire Department or his or her designee and the Chief of the Mamaroneck Police Department or his or her designee. The ex officio members will serve in an advisory capacity only and will not be voting members of the Board. At least three of the community members must have a background of experience in engineering, systems analysis or general business experience.

Section 2.

Section 72-4 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is amended as follows:

§ 72-4 Procedure for enactment of regulations.

No traffic or parking regulation adopted by the Board of Traffic Commissioners shall be effective unless and until:

- A. It has been adopted by a majority vote of the full voting membership of the Board.
- B. It has been certified to the Board of Trustees by the Board of Traffic Commissioners as a regulation duly adopted by it.
- C. It has been approved by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 4.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law § 10(1)(e)(3). It supersedes the provisions of the Village Law to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 5.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
