### **LOCAL LAW 6 - 2017**

## A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 326, VEHICLES & TRAFFIC AS IT RELATES TO THE FINE FOR BOAT RAMP PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

### **SECTION 1.**

Chapter 326-65(D) is hereby deleted in its entirety:

### **SECTION 2.**

Chapter 326-66(B) is hereby amended as follows:

B. Boat trailer permit parking only area: Any person violating any of the provisions of Article IV of this chapter in relation to boat trailer or boater permit parking only, except § 326-49G and H, may, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$50.

### **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY**

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

#### **SECTION 4.** Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon adoption and filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
