LOCAL LAW 8-2018

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 326, VEHICLES & TRAFFIC AS IT RELATES TO PARKING PERMITS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

Chapter 326. Vehicles and Traffic

Section 1.

Chapter 326-41 Decals Required Subsection (L) is hereby added as follows:

L. Parking Permit Area GP-I where such decal holder may park between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.

Section 2.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 3.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law §10(1)(e)(3) and will supersede the provisions of the Village Law to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 4.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
