# PROPOSED LOCAL LAW BB- 2017

A Proposed Local Law to amend Chapter 326, Vehicles & Traffic as it relates to Parking in the Metered Parking Zone 7 (Phillips Park Road)

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows: Language in strike-through abedefhijk to be deleted; language in **bold** is to be added

Chapter 326. Vehicles and Traffic

### Section I.

Chapter 326-39 Areas Established Subsection (B)(8) is hereby added as follows:

(8) all the parking spaces on both sides of Phillips Park Road from East Prospect Avenue to Spencer Place.

## Section 2.

Chapter 326-52 Time Limits Subsection (D) is hereby amended as follows:

D. The parking of vehicles in Metered Parking Zones 7, 8, 10(c) only the two spaces on the south side of Halstead Avenue over the Mamaroneck River, established by this article, for a period in excess of four hours is prohibited. **The parking of vehicles in Metered Parking Zone 7 with a valid GP permit, established by Article IV of this Chapter, for a period in excess of 10 hours is prohibited.** 

# Section 3.

Chapter 326-54 Fees Subsection (G) is hereby amended as follows:

G. A fee of \$0.25 for 30 minutes, or any fraction thereof, for a maximum of four hours, is hereby established for parking in Metered Parking Zones 7, 8 and 21.
Vehicles with a valid GP permit, established by Article IV of this Chapter, shall not be required to pay any fees to park in Metered Parking Zone 7.

### Section 4.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 5.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law 10(1)(e)(3) and will supersede the provisions of the Village Law to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 6.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
