

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW G – 2022

A Proposed Local Law to amend Chapter 9 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck (Board of Trustees), regarding the authority to fill vacancies on the Board of Trustees

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAMARONECK
AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1.

Section 9-5 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended by adding a new subsection D, as follows:

- (D) Superseding section 3-312(3)(b) of the Village Law of the State of New York, the authority to fill vacancies in the office of Village Trustee, which is given to the Board of Trustees by Village Code § 9-6(N).**

Section 2.

Section 9-6 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended by adding the following:

- (N) persons to fill vacancies in the office of Village Trustee, superseding section 3-312(3) of the Village Law of the State of New York, to be otherwise exercised in accordance with the requirements of section 3-312 of the Village Law of the State of New York.**

Section 3.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law §10(1)(e)(3). It is intended to and does supersede Village Law § 3-312(3) and any other provision of the Village Law, to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 4.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 5.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its approval by referendum by the electors of the Village of Mamaroneck and its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
