

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW I – 2022

A Proposed Local Law to amend Chapter 326, Vehicles and Traffic, regarding the Village-wide speed limit

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAMARONECK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Section 326-6 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

§ 326-6 Speed Limits.

The maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed on or along any streets or highways within the Village, excluding state highways, is hereby established at **30** ~~25~~ miles per hour, ~~except that the speed limit for vehicles proceeding on or along those streets or parts of streets described in Schedule II (§ 326-69), attached to and made a part of this chapter, shall be as indicated in said schedule.~~

Section 2.

Section 326-69 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is repealed.

Section 3.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 4.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law §10(1)(e)(3) and will supersede the provisions of the Village Law to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 5.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
