

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW N-2018

A Proposed Local Law to amend Chapter 326, Vehicles & Traffic, as it relates to parking regulation

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

Chapter 326. Vehicles and Traffic

Section 1.

Section 326.40(B) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

- B.** In addition to the overnight permit parking previously established in the lower level of the Hunter Lot, overnight parking is hereby established in the permit parking areas known as "Spencer Lot," "Prospect Lot" and "Johnson Lot." "ON" permits for parking at meters in the Spencer Lot are required between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and 8:00 a.m. Parking by the general public is allowed at Spencer Lot **and Johnson Lot** meters only during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight).

Section 2.

Section 326.41(C) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

- C.** Only ON decal holders shall park in the GP Permit Parking Areas known as "Hunter Lot" (lower level), "Spencer Lot" **and** "Prospect Lot" ~~and "Johnson Lot"~~ between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. of the next succeeding day.

Section 3.

Section 326-51(F) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

- F.** Zone **6a**: the paved parking area adjacent to the Mamaroneck Free Library located underneath the Emelin Theatre, designated as "Metered Parking Zone **6a**," but only so much of said area as may be designated by signs as a metered parking zone. **Zone 6b: the Johnson Lot designated as "Metered Parking Zone 6b.**

Section 4.

Section 326-52(C) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

- C.** The parking of vehicles in Metered Parking Zones 10(c), except the two spaces on the south side of Halstead Avenue over the Mamaroneck River, 11, 12, 14, 16(a), 16(b), 17 and 20, established by this article, for a period in excess of two hours is prohibited.

Section 5.

Section 326-52(K) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby added as follows:

K. The parking of vehicles in Metered Parking Zones 6a and 6b, established by this article, for a period in excess of three hours is prohibited except however for the parking of vehicles in Metered Parking Zone 6b with a valid GP permit.

Section 6.

Chapter 326-54(C) is hereby amended as follows:

C. A fee of \$0.25 for 30 minutes is hereby established for parking in Metered Parking Zones 6a, 6b and 22.

Section 7.

Chapter 326-54(G) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

G. A fee of \$0.25 for ~~30~~ **20** minutes, or any fraction thereof, for a maximum of four hours, is hereby established for parking in Metered Parking Zones 7, 8 and 21.

Section 8.

Section 326-54(K) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

K. A fee of \$0.25 for ~~30~~ **20** minutes, or any fraction thereof, for a maximum of two hours, is hereby established for parking in the first through sixth spaces commencing from Sheldrake Place in Metered Parking Zone 2(b), and for the metered spaces in Parking Zone 10(d).

Section 9.

Section 326-54(L) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

L. A fee of \$0.25 for ~~30~~ **20** minutes, or any fraction thereof, for a maximum of one hour, is hereby established for parking in Metered Parking Zone 5.

Section 10.

Section 326-54(P) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

P. A fee of \$0.25 for ~~30~~ **20** minutes, or any fraction thereof, for a maximum of eight hours, is hereby established for parking in Metered Parking Zones 10(a) and 10(e), with no minimum.

Section 11.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 12.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law §10(1)(e)(3) and will supersede the provisions of the Village Law to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 13.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
